Did you know? Women only make up 11% of investing partners at venture capital firms. Investors tend to invest in people who look like them, and so maybe it's not surprising that only around 13% of venture capital dollars go to startups with a woman on the founding team. In contrast, women make up a higher percentage of the angel market: 38.9% in 2022, and that same year, 25.6% of women entrepreneurs who sought angel funding were able to successfully secure it. More women investing = more women-led companies getting funding!

Description: Join us for a lunch and learn workshop in collaboration with Render Capital as their team covers the ins and outs of angel investing in high-growth potential startups. What is an accredited investor? How do you become an accredited investor, and what are the risks that come along with angel investing? Do you have to choose between investing in companies that can create a return on your investment and companies whose missions you believe in? (Spoiler alert: you don't have to choose!)

Other interesting facts about women and investing

In 2023, 86 women-led funds raised \$3.5B up from \$3B raised by women-led funds in 2022

That \$3.5B out of \$107B raised by VC funds so 3% of VC funding went to women-led funds in 2023, up from 1.3% in 2022

Women-led startups accounted for ~26% of deal volume in 2023 but only translated to 2.6% of invested dollars in VC

Female founders in discussions face more negative questioning regardless of the investors' gender vs. male founders receive more positive questioning on outlook

As of 2023, only ~18% of investment decision-makers are women

Venture-backed companies led by women are more capital-efficient, achieving 35% higher ROI, and 12% higher revenue than startups run by men in 2023

Wisdom Series: Panel Discussion of Dan Pallotta's TED Talk: The way we think about charity is dead wrong

Tuesday, March 19, 6-7:30 pm Virtual

Activist and fundraiser Dan Pallotta calls out the double standard that drives our broken relationship to charities. Too many nonprofits, he says, are rewarded for how little they spend -- not for what they get done. Instead of equating frugality with morality, he asks us to start rewarding charities for their big goals and big accomplishments (even if that comes with big expenses). In the bold talk, he says: Let's change the way we think about changing the world.
